Just meandering around the farm you'll see Shep, the farm border collie, herding ducks around the yard, cows, gardens, and tractor pulled wagons. You'll want to hop on because the wagons will take on one of the dairy's most popular tours. The Dairy Tour starts off with a hayride and herding demonstration by Scott Cagle's award-winning Border Collies. You will see baby calves being bottle fed, and get a first-hand look at how a live cow is milked. You will also visit the Processing Facility. Children will learn how milk gets from the cow to the grocery store!

There is no end to the activities offered on the farm. You can take part in one of their many tours, find your way through the Cagle's corn MAiZE, or join in for a hayride and weenie roast!

The surrounding community offers lots of activities as well, there are trails, museums, historic sites, the mountains, or you can just sit down for a family meal.
